## **NOTES:**

- 1. Please notify the Gifts Secretary at St Martin's Church (Stuart Campbell, 34 Hutchison View, Edinburgh EH14 1RX) if you change your name or address while your Gift Aid Declaration remains in force.
- 2. You may cancel your declaration at any time by notifying the Gifts Secretary. Such cancellation will take effect for donations made on and after its receipt or from such later date as you specify.
- 3. You must pay an amount of qualifying tax at least equal to the tax to be reclaimed on all your gift aid donations in the tax year. (This is currently 25p for each £1 you give.)
- 4. If your circumstances change and you no longer pay tax on your income (including non-refundable tax credits and capital gains tax) at least equal to the tax to be reclaimed, you should cancel your declaration (see note 2).
